Promote understanding of each MEHC member's roles and responsibilities in healthcare delivery system's emergency response

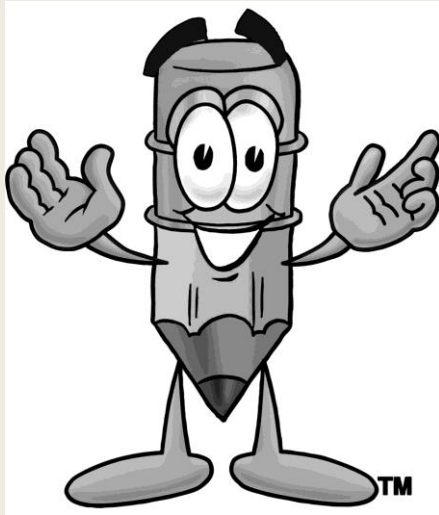
