- Human and animal food emergencies

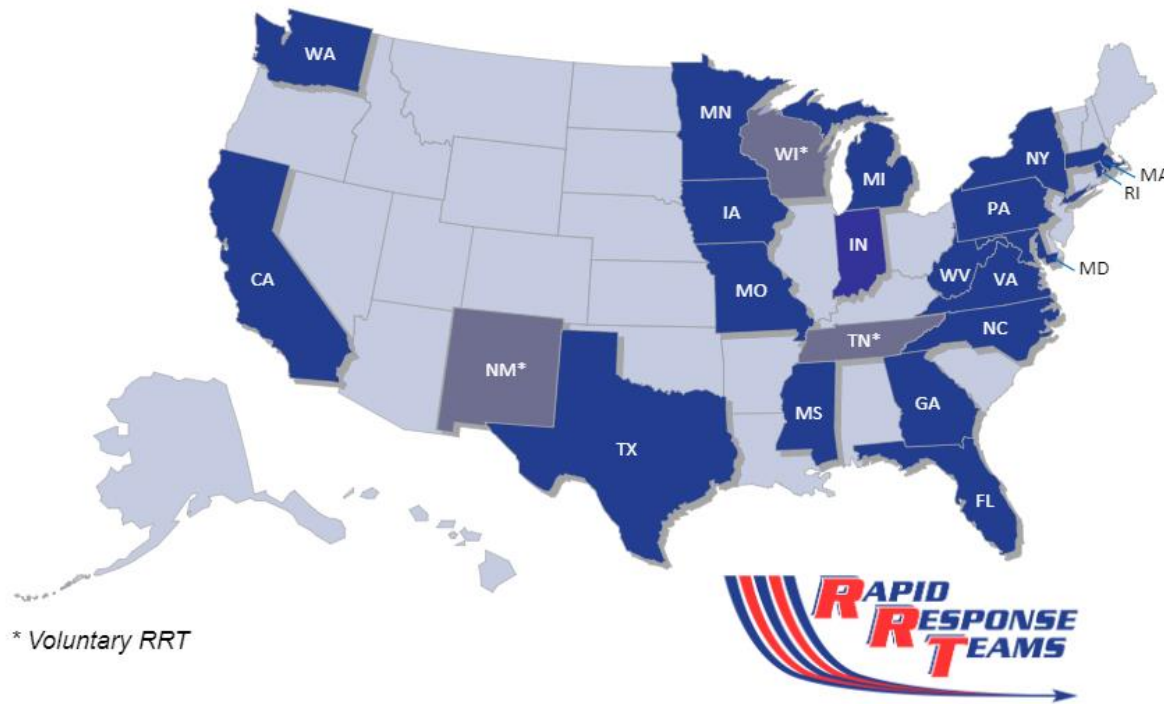


# What does SMRRT do?

- Identify potential preventive practices to reduce foodborne illness and injury.



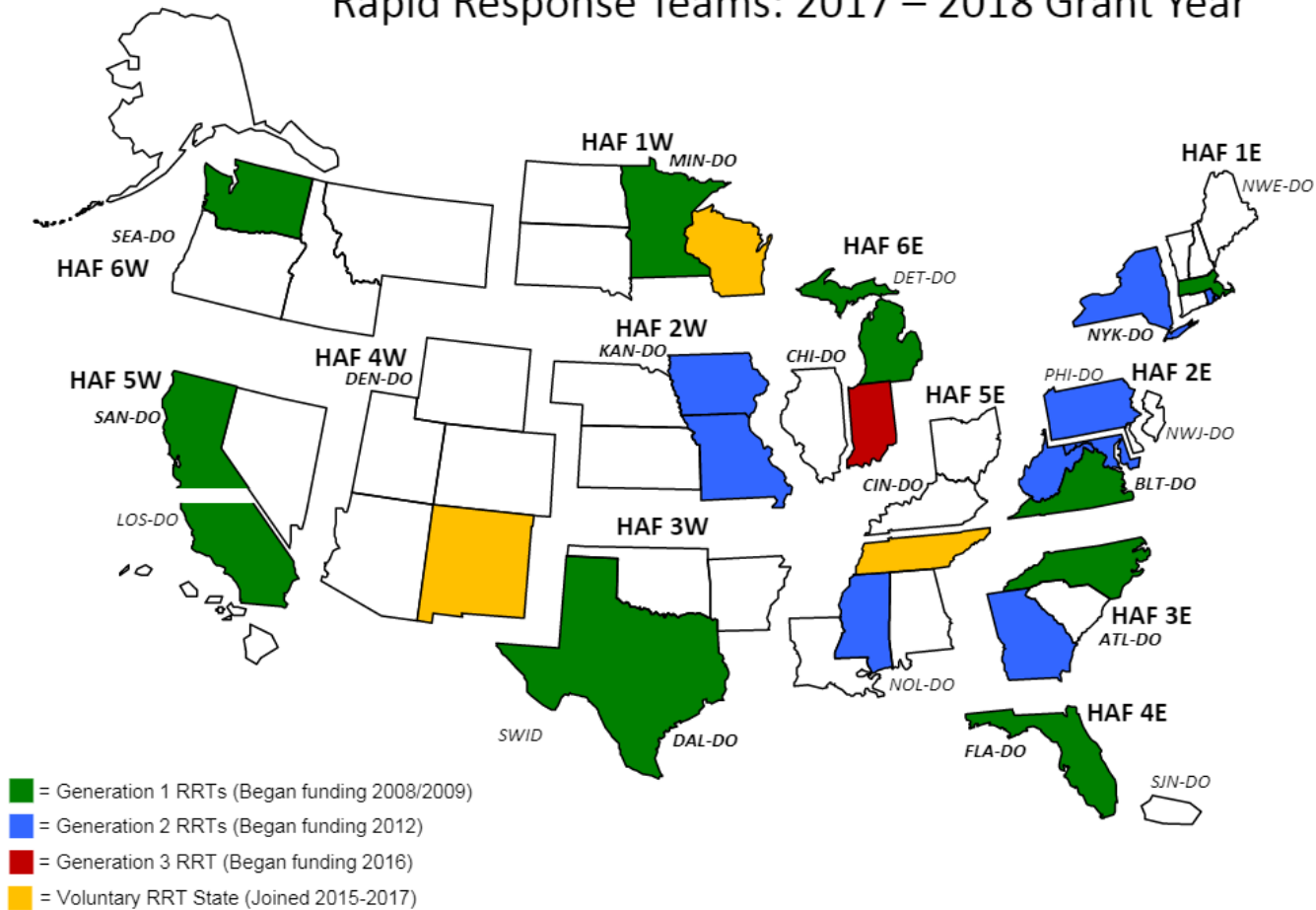

# RRTs by FDA District

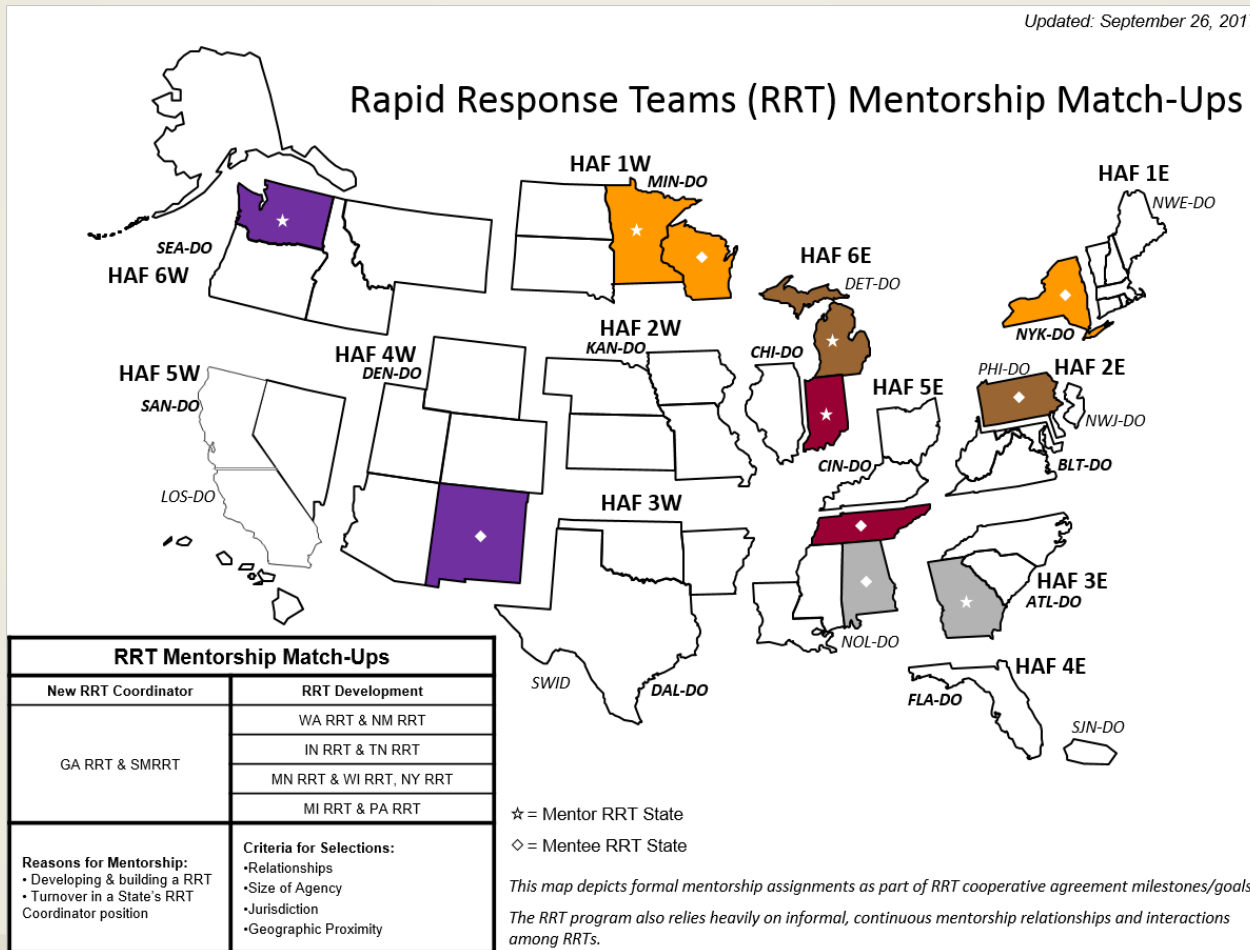

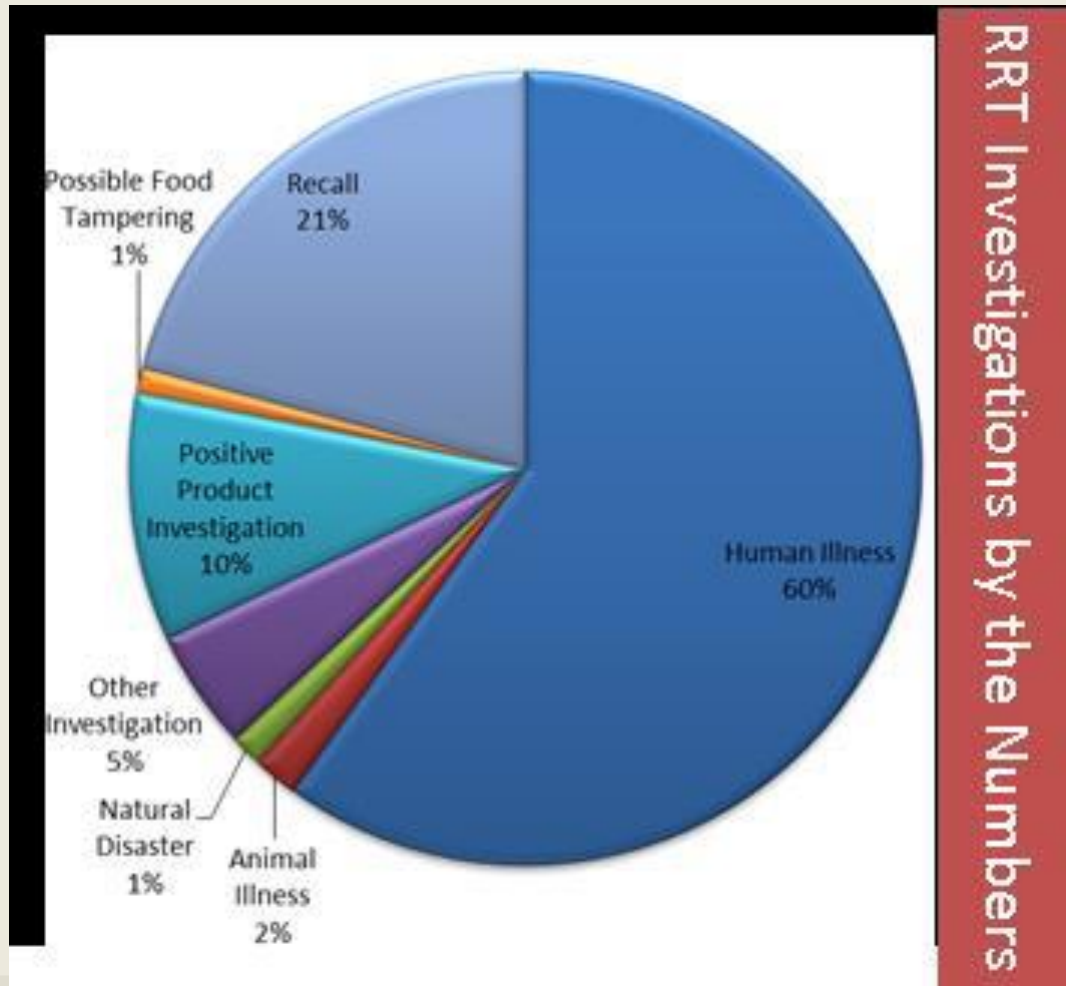

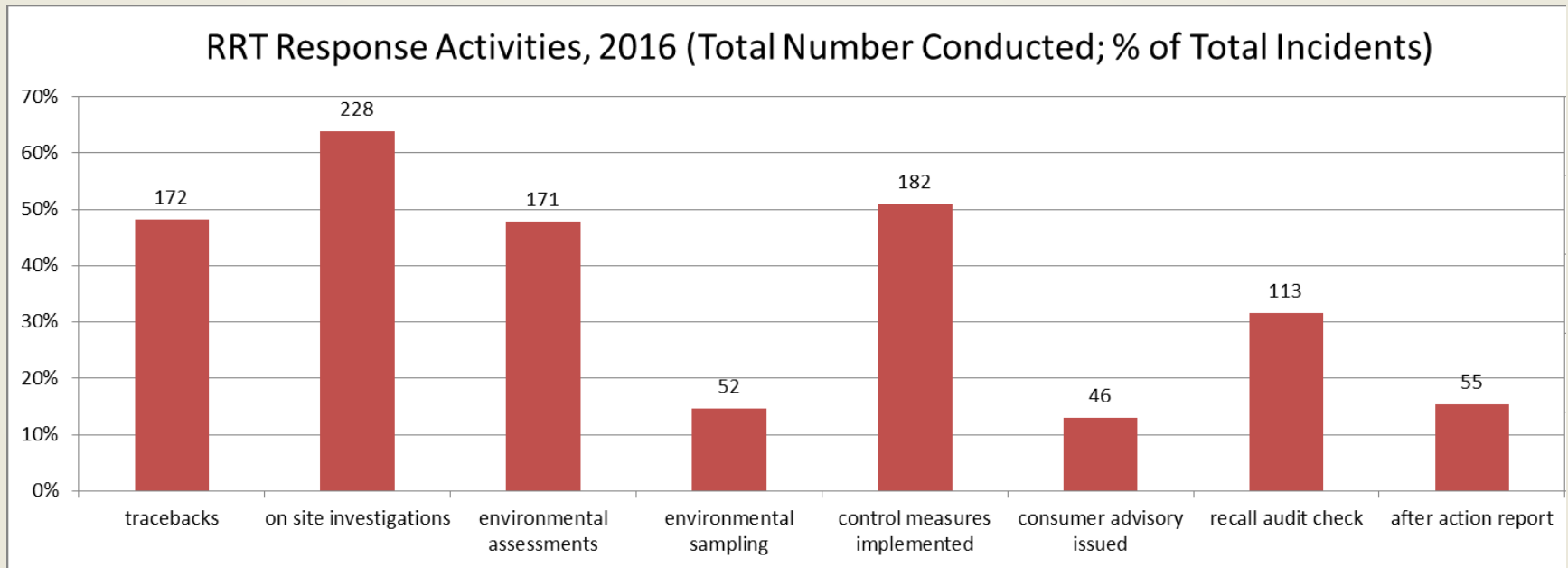

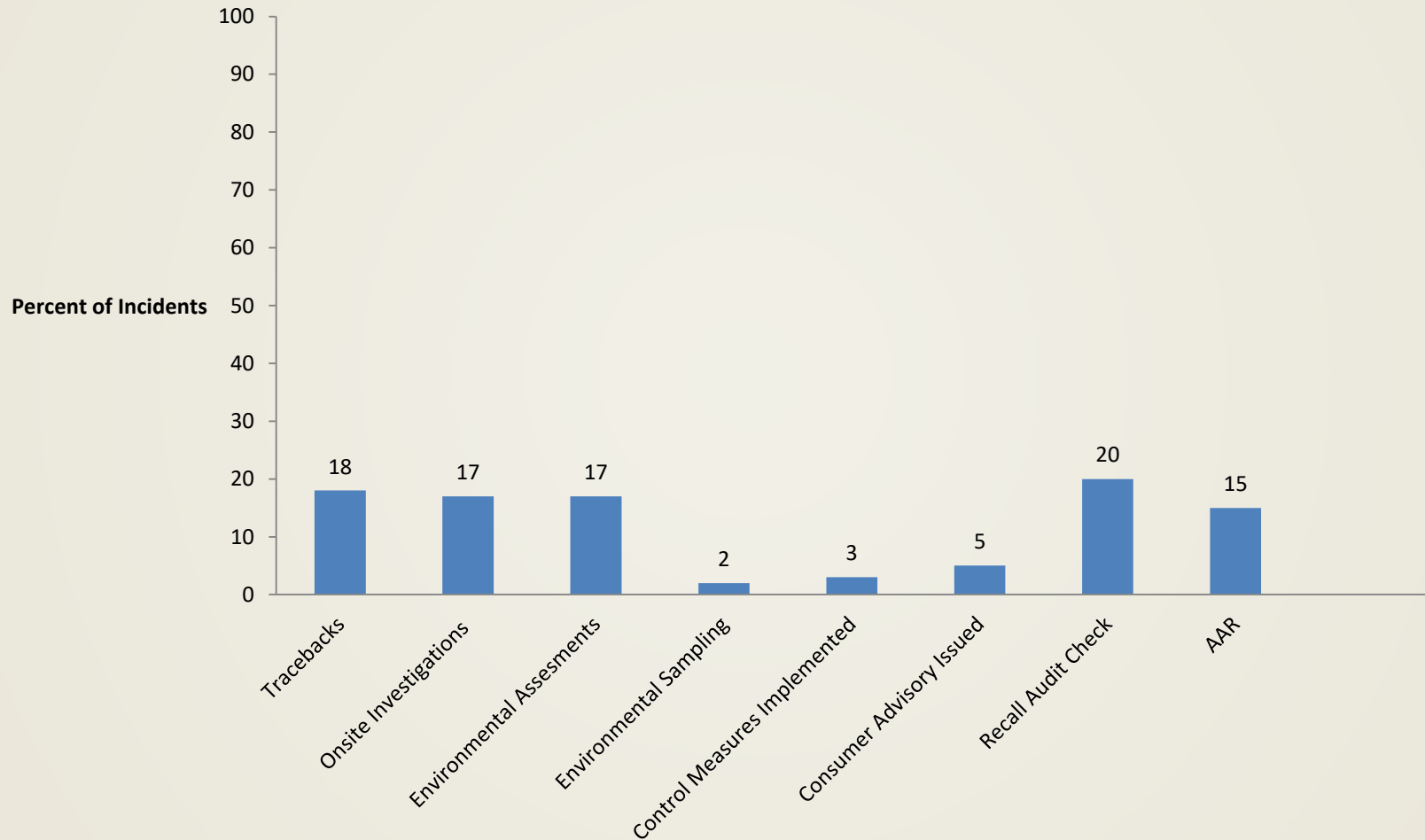


# RRT Activities by Type





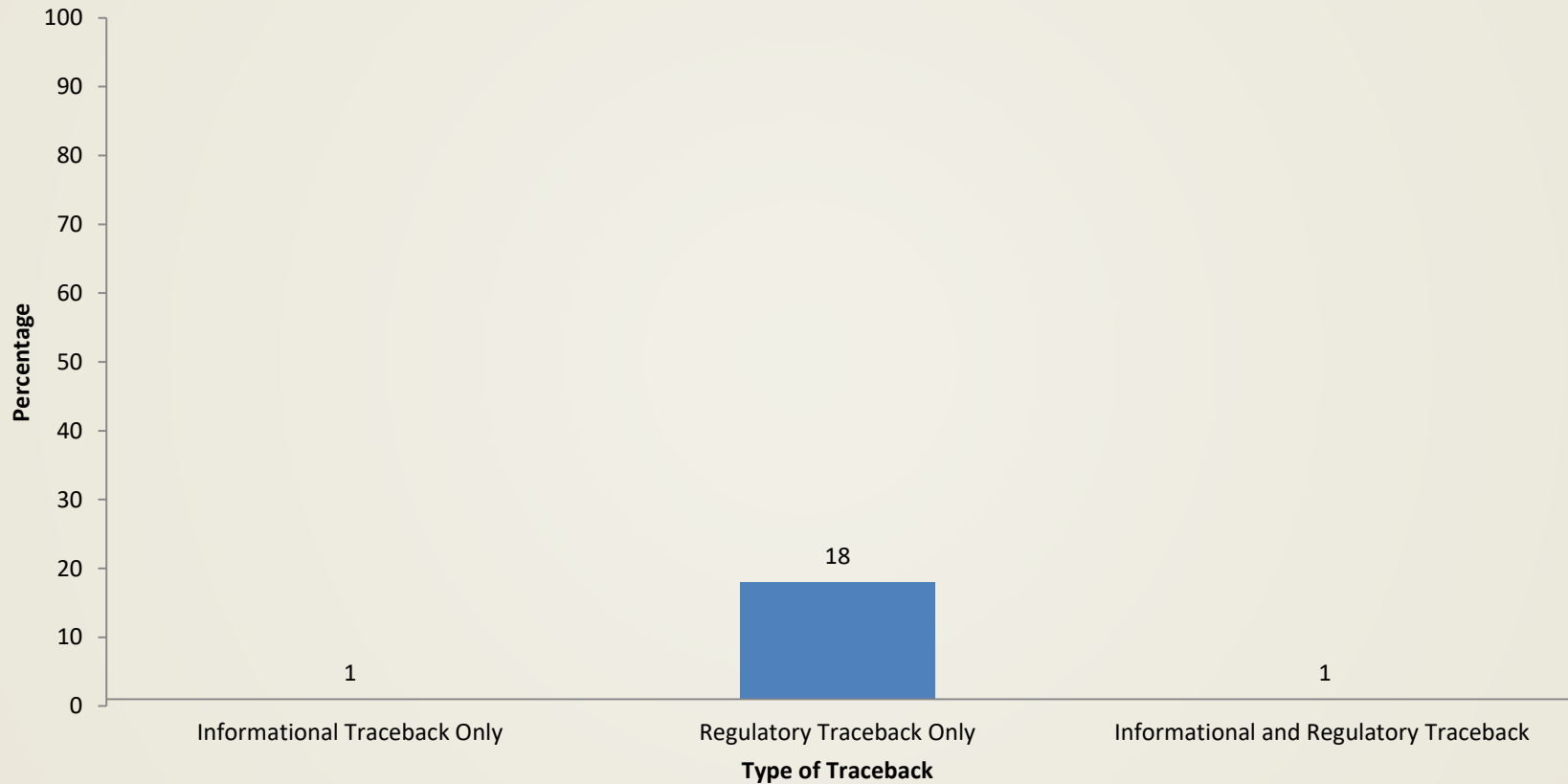
# SMRRT Response Activities, 2017-2018



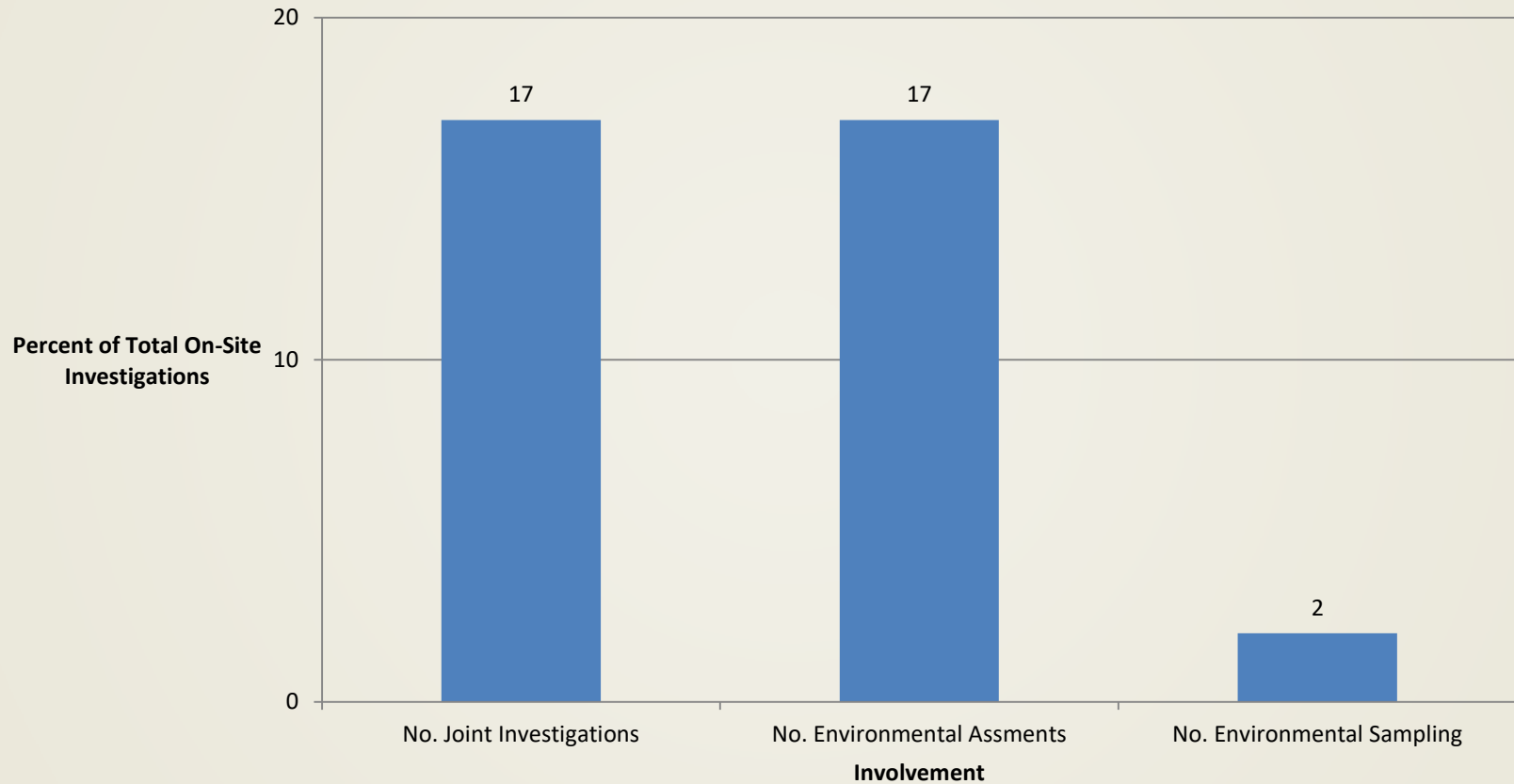

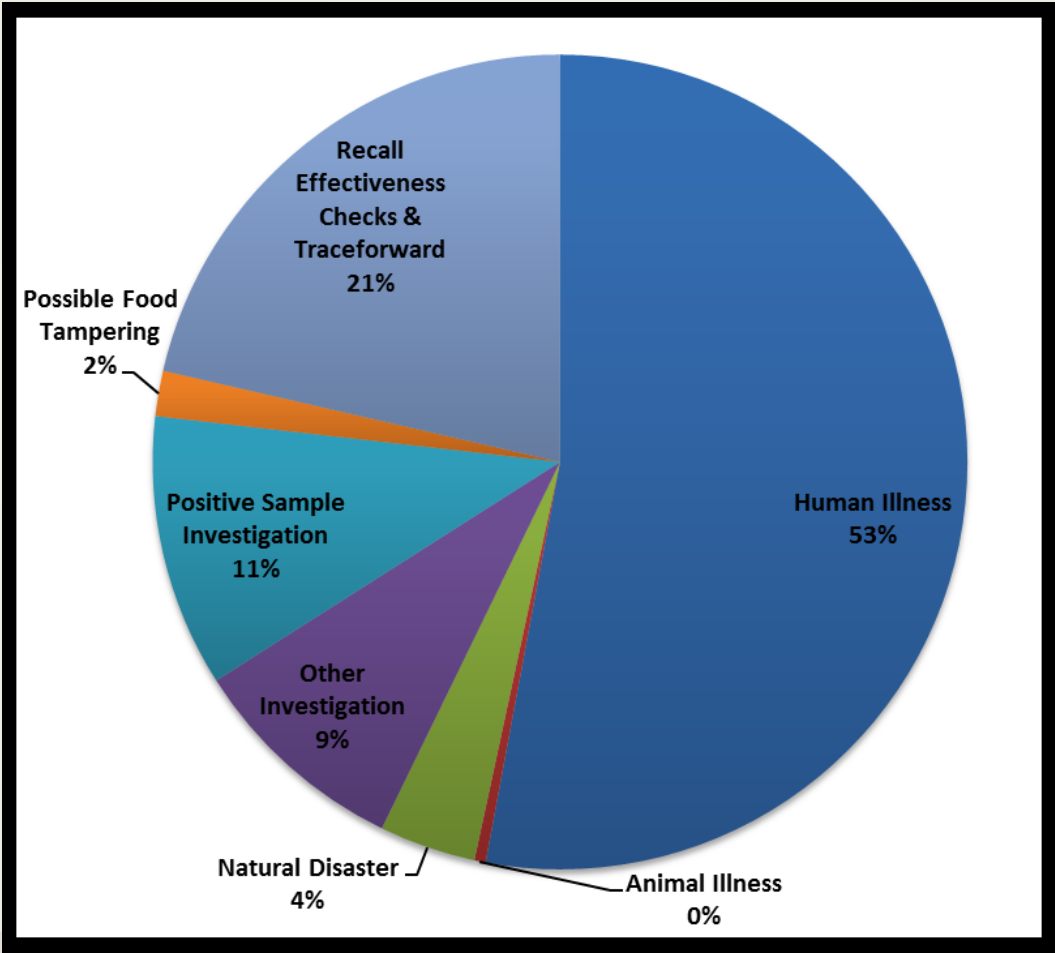
# SMRRT Traceback Investigations 2017-2018

# Overview of 2017 RRT CAT Data

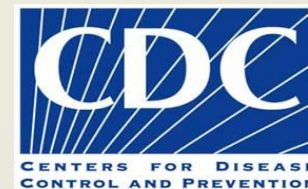

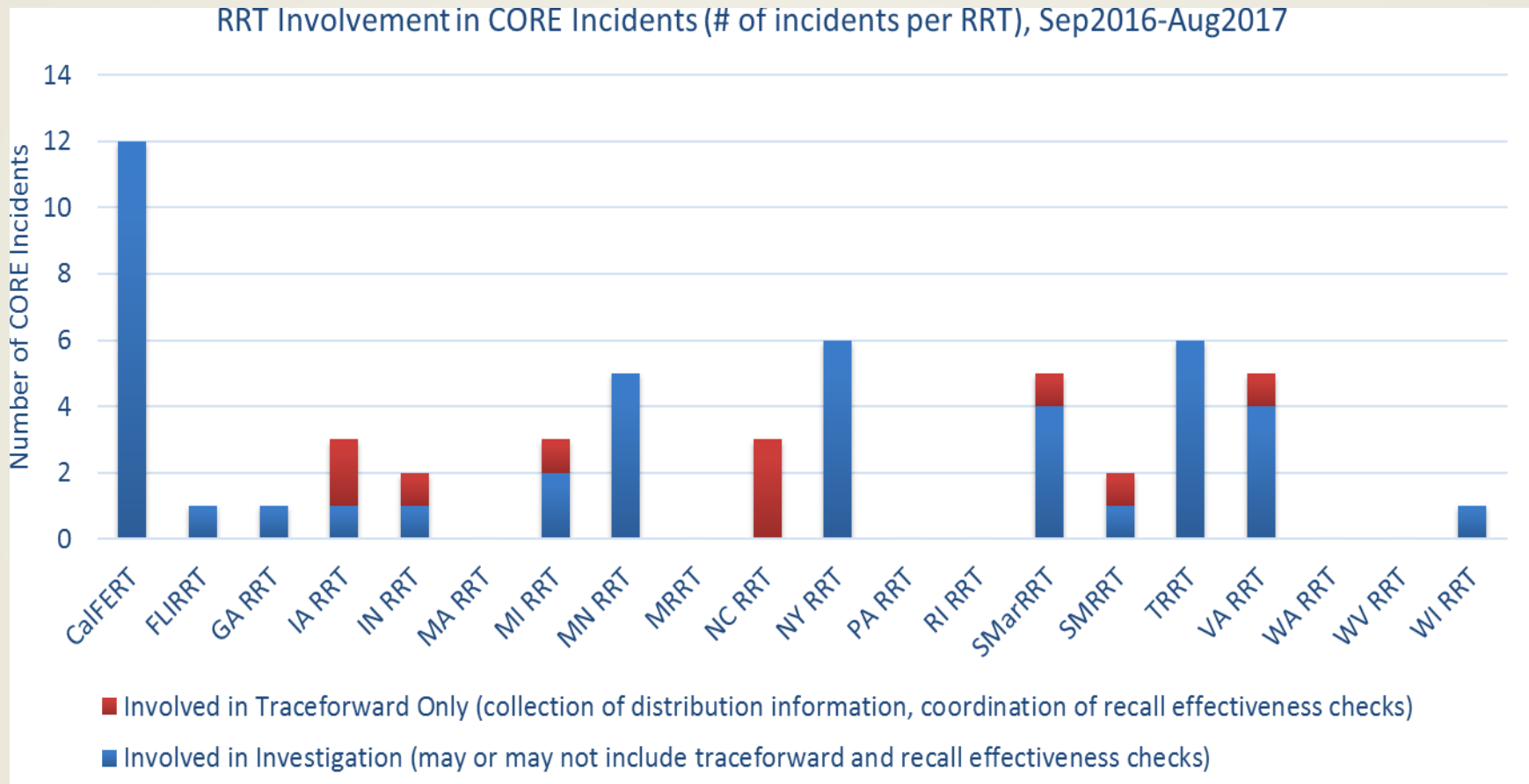


# Disaster Impacts on Food Facilities
